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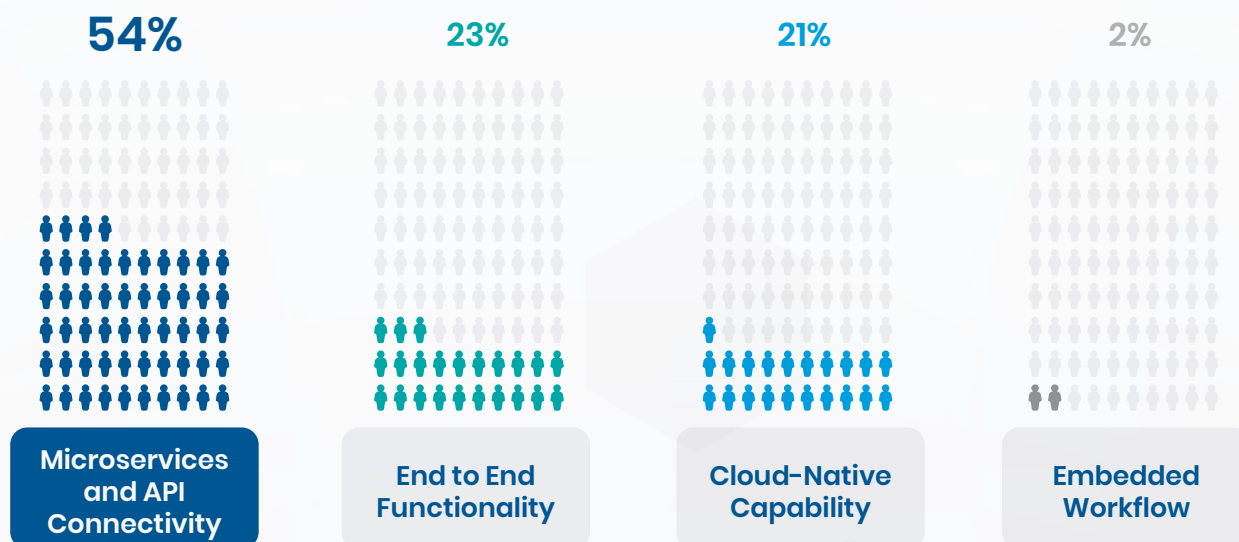

At the heart of this transformation are the NextGen core banking systems that provide banks with a cloud-based, modular, and flexible banking infrastructure. An analysis of global NextGen Core system deals, based on IBSi's proprietary SalesVision data, shows a notable increase in the sales of NextGen Core systems, from just 1% in 2017-2019 to 15% in 2020-2022.

These agile systems support APIs allowing banks to scale operations rapidly, add new functionality, and integrate applications and services with ease. More than half of the respondents in a recent poll conducted by IBS intelligence, identified "Microservices and API connectivity" to be the most important attribute of modern core banking systems.

NextGen core platforms also offer real-time processing capabilities that enable banks to process transactions instantly and use machine learning and AI to automate processes and make data-driven decisions.
